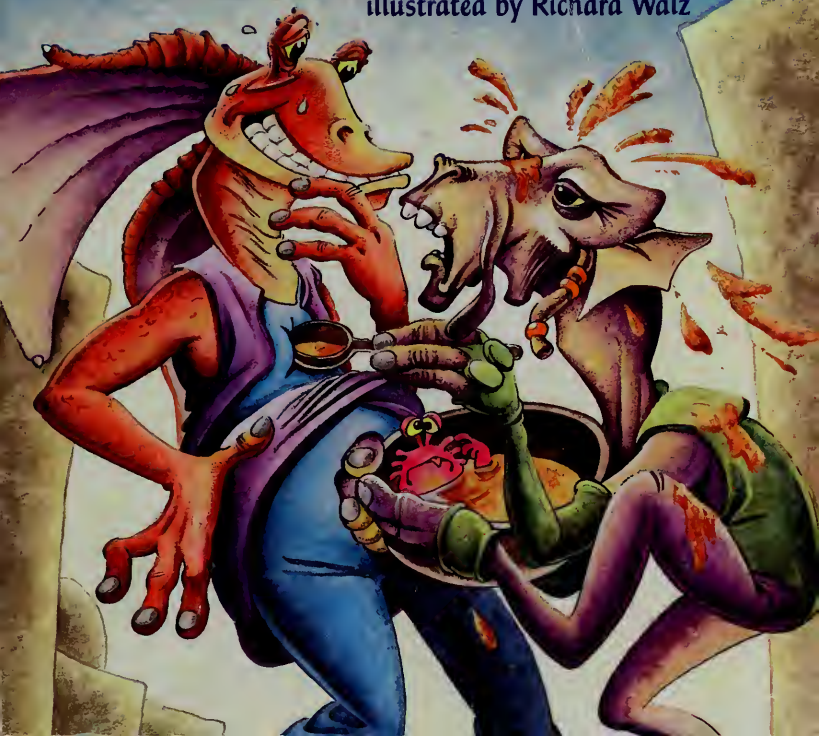

The grade levels assigned to the five steps—preschool through kindergarten for the Early Books, preschool through grade 1 for Step 1, grades 1 through 3 for Step 2, grades 2 through 3 for Step 3, and grades 2 through 4 for Step 4—are intended only as guides. Some children move through all five steps very rapidly; others climb the steps over a period of several years. Either way, these books will help your child “step into reading” in style!

He opens his mouth.





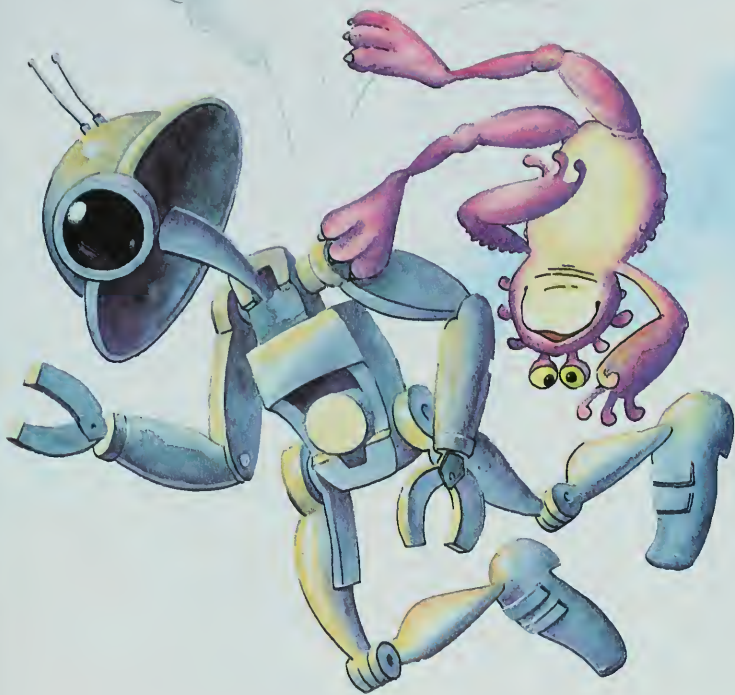
Pop!

a bowl of soup.



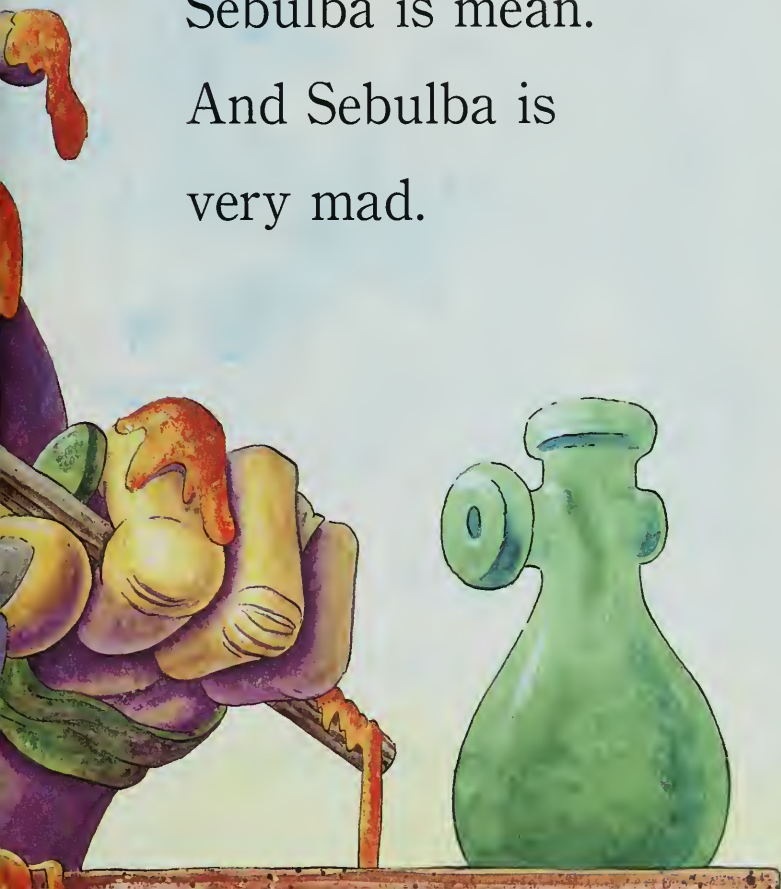


It is Sebulba's soup.

Jar Jar down.





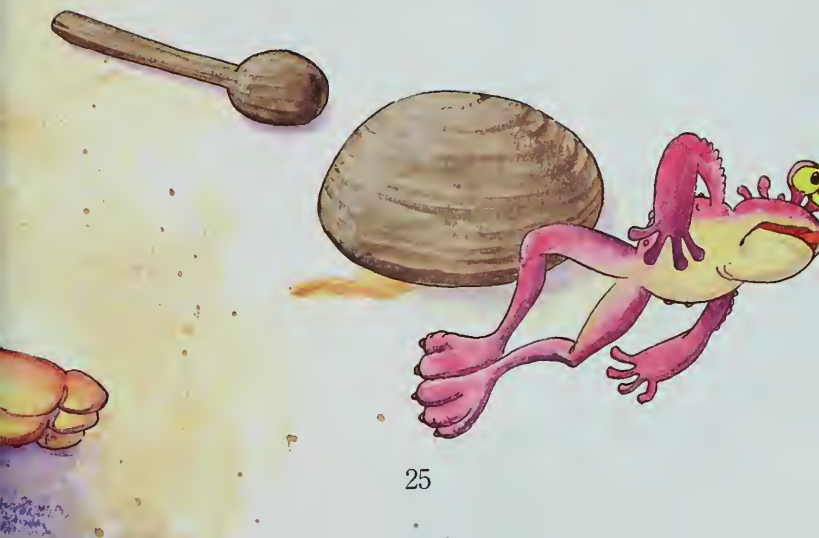


Jar Jar closes his
